1 Introduction

nestor is the German competence network for digital preservation. It is well established within the community of cultural heritage institutions and a recognized authority in the wider public. In 2013 nestor will continue its activities, sustain its services and develop new resources and services according to the demand of its community. This document outlines the planned activities of the network in 2013.

2 Key issues

The last couple of years saw progress in the preservation of digital images and textual media. Since 2012 DIN 31644 and ISO 16363 provide standards for systems of digital preservation.

The major task is now to implement the concepts and standards in the bulk of cultural heritage institutions. Many institutions in Germany, especially nestor-partners, develop services and offer cooperation in digital preservation matters to third parties. nestor actively supports this development and will offer a platform to promote these new services on its annual nestor-Praktikertag (practioners day).

The nestor working group on certification has finalized a criteria catalogue and will start with the evaluation and certification of digital preservation systems in 2013.

On a conceptual level nestor will focus on the preservation of audiovisual media.



3 Partnerships

nestor is looking for new partners and will continue its growth in 2013. The cooperation with other initiatives will be continue, for example with Deutsche Digitale Bibliothek (DDB), Allianz zur Erhaltung schriftliches Kulturguts and Deutsche Initiative für Netzwerkinformation (DINI).

On an international level, nestor will further engage in the Alliance for Permanent Access (APA). A cooperation agreement (2012) with the Digital Preservation Coalition (DPC) will enable a closer engagement.

4 Working groups

This section describes the plans from nestor working groups for 2013.

Training and Qualification

The successful nestor schools will continue in 2013. The recently published book on the preservation on scientific data will be translated into English.

WG media

The WG will develop strategies and recommendations for the digital preservation of audiovisual media with a focus on the integration in established work flows.

WG digital preservation

The new version of the guideline on digital preservation (2012) will be actively promoted, for example with a workshop on the annual meeting of German librarians (Bibliothekartag). The guidelines will also be translated into English.

WG certification

The WG will start to offer certification according to DIN 31644. A catalog of criteria will be published in German and English in 2013. While the criteria are already available for interested parties a formal publication needs to wait for the publication of a companion guide to DIN 31644 by the publisher Beuth-Verlag.

WG costs

The WG will publish guidelines on costs in 2013.

WG preservation policy

The WG will publish guidelines on institutional preservation policies in 2013. Yvonne Friese will present the work on the IASSIST 2013.
